Typical Daily Schedule

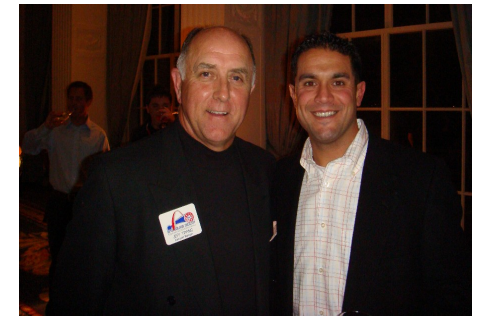
- 9:00 am—9:30 am = Attendance, dynamic warm-up & ball/foot-work
